Carolina and county of Mecklenburg, being weak of body by of perfect mind and memory blessed be God, do make ordain appoint and constitute the is my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, I.E., First I give my Soul to God from whom I received it, my body I commit to this earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner as the direction of my Executors and as for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bestow on me I give and bequeath in ___ and form following to which first I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Nanna Hargett this land and plantation where I now live with all my stock consisting of hogs, horses and cattle, household furniture of working tools and every other good I _____ of one hundred acres of land at the ___ ___ after all just debt is paid, with one cow called Tillie given to Elizabeth Chaney one heifer to William Chaney Jun., one heifer named Traudley. Except the above gifts all my land goods ___ and property I give to my well beloved wife Nanna Hargett during her natural life and after her demise it is my last Will and Testament that the whole Estate ___ and personal be equally divided among my children Henry Hargett Jun., Elizabeth Chaney, Peter Hargett, Rachele Pullman, Rebecca Broom, Joseph Hargett, Mary Craig, Sarah Holms, Daniel Hargett, _____ Leany. Lastly I nominate appoint and constitute the my last Will and Testament in the hand of my beloved sons Henry Hargett Jun. And Joseph Hargett ___ to this my last Will and Testament I witness where of I the said Henry Hargett Sen. Have here with set my hand and seal this 28th day of March 1803
